06. 2014 Nordic Indoor Haugesund
The future of the Nordic Veterans Indoor Championship was discussed. At the championships in Haugesund 270 athletes are registered - 20 are from Finland, 23 from Sweden, 9 from Denmark, 2 from Iceland, 1 from Estonia and 215 from Norway.
According to the plan for the future Nordic championships, Sweden will organize the Nordic Indoor in 2016. If the EVAA decides to organize European Indoor that same year, the Nordic Veteran Committee will have to make a decision of the rotation of the indoor and outdoor games at a meeting in Izmir. Here the Nordic Veteran Committee also must make their decision about the future of the indoor games.

07. 2014 Economic support to team leaders to European and World Championships
In Denmark, Iceland, Sweden and Norway masters athletics are headed by committees, sorting under the respective national federations. Finland, however, has established a masters athletics federation, independent of the Finnish track and field federation, with a considerably larger budget than those of the masters athletics committees in the other Nordic countries.
The Icelandic team leaders do not get any economic support from their masters athletics committee, when going to European and World Championships. The team leaders of Denmark and Norway get a small amount of money, to cover some of their accommodation and travel expenses. Three team leaders/delegates from Sweden get all their accommodation and travel expenses covered.
08. 2014 Fees in connection with European and World Championships
At several of the last European and World Championships the LOC have made an extra fee for each payment (\$10 or €10). These fees are paid directly to the LOC, which are responsible to transfer them to the respective national masters athletics federations/committees. A letter will be sent from the Nordic Veteran Committee to WMA and EVAA, asking them to ensure that these fees are indeed transferred to the national federations/committees.
09. 2014 Nordic records
A statistician from the Swedish Veterans Committee is responsible for updating the Nordic veterans record lists, with support from statisticians in each of the Nordic countries.
10. 2014 European Masters Games
Vesa Lappalainen informed about the upcoming European Masters Games (EMG) and how they will be organized. Currently, EVAA and the International Masters Games Association (IMGA), which is responsible for EMG, are considering whether EVACS should be a part of EMG. One of the reasons for this is that EVACS and EMG will take place the same year in 2017 or 2019. This issue will be discussed further in Izmir.
